

Summary of Measures – Eligibility Criteria and Disbursement Mode/Timing

S/N	Measure	Eligibility Criteria	Disbursement Mode/Timing
Large Families Scheme			
1	Child Development Account (CDA) First Step Grant of \$10,000 (doubled from \$5,000 today)	Parents with a third or subsequent SC child born on or after 18 February 2025. All SC children currently receive \$5,000.	Deposited into the eligible child's CDA, around two weeks after CDA opening (starting from end-February 2025)
2	Large Family MediSave Grant (LFMG) of \$5,000	Parents with a third or subsequent SC child born on or after 18 February 2025. This is on top of the MGN ¹ provided to all SC newborns.	Deposited into the mother's MediSave account, around two weeks after child's successful enrolment into the Baby Bonus Scheme (starting from mid-March 2025)
3	Large Family LifeSG Credits (LFLC) of \$1,000 annually, for up to six years	Parents with three or more SC children will receive LFLC for each of their third or subsequent children (born on or after 1 January 2019), in the years that the child turns one to six ² .	For eligible children born in 2019 to 2024 , the first disbursement of LFLC will occur in September 2025 ³ . For eligible children born from 2025 onwards , the first disbursement of LFLC will occur from April 2026 onwards. The CDA trustee of each eligible child will be able to access the LFLC via a digital wallet in the LifeSG application.

¹ The MGN will be increased from \$4,000 to \$5,000 for babies born from 1 April 2025.

² Eligibility will be determined as of 1 March each year, and the LFLC will be subsequently disbursed in April of the same year.

³ The first-ever disbursement will be an exception, where eligibility will be determined as of 1 August 2025, and the LFLC will be subsequently disbursed in September of the same year.
